

Official Notice

1. Croydon Council, with the agreement of Transport for London, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate engineering works associated with tram maintenance works they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to introduce any of the following traffic measures in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or in any adjoining street to those specified:
 - (a) temporarily close to vehicular traffic where this is considered necessary to facilitate the work in progress;
 - (b) temporarily introduce banned turns or waiting restrictions at any time throughout the week should this be required;
 - (c) introduce one-way traffic for the duration of the works;
 - (d) temporarily revoke bus and tram only lanes and cycle lanes as and when necessary;
 - (e) temporarily suspend any parking bays;
 - (f) temporarily introduce width restrictions or weight restrictions as and when necessary;
 - (g) temporarily introduce any other traffic management measures as required to facilitate the work in progress as and when necessary.
2. Wherever the work happens to be in progress in those streets or lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice, no person may cause or permit any vehicle to:-
 - (a) proceed in a direction other than that indicated by a traffic sign, or
 - (b) proceed in any street or length of street which may at the time be subject to a road closure until the completion of the work allows.
3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative routes for diverted traffic will be signposted accordingly.
4. The Order will come into operation on the 14 August 2010 and will remain in force for 18 months.

(Note: The provisions of the Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002. (Vehicular access will be maintained).

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS BENNETT'S AVENUE, CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate electrical connections they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Bennett's Avenue, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place temporary 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced in Bennett's Avenue between its junction with Shirley Way and the north-western boundary of No. 14 Bennett's Avenue.
3. The Order will come into operation on 3 August 2010 and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in 5 days commencing on 3 August 2010. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.

(Vehicular access will be maintained)

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED BY SECTION 4 (7) OF SCHEDULE 5 TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1985 AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

BRIGHTON ROAD, CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, with the agreement of Transport for London **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate engineering works associated with the Southern Gas Network mains replacement scheme they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Brighton Road, Croydon.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:-
 - (a) no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Brighton Road, between its junctions with Purley Road and Biddulph Road;
 - (b) a one-way working north-eastbound will be introduced in Brighton Road, between its junctions with Purley Road and Whytecliffe Road South;
 - (c) temporarily introduce banned turns or waiting and loading restrictions 'At any time' in Brighton Road, between its junctions with Purley Road

- and Biddulph Road should this be required;
 - (d) temporarily introduce any other temporary traffic management measures into roads adjoining Brighton Road, between its junctions with Purley Road and Biddulph Road or upon the diversion route outlined.
3. Whilst the said works are taking place the alternative route for south-east bound traffic will be via Whytecliffe Road South and Purley Road.
 4. The Order will come into operation on the 16 August 2010 and it is anticipated that the work will be carried out in 20 weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.

(Vehicular access will be maintained throughout the works via the diversion routes)

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS CARGREEN ROAD, CLIFFORD ROAD, LAWRENCE ROAD AND STATION ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate works in connection with the South Norwood Station Improvement Scheme they intend to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Cargreen Road, Clifford Road, Lawrence Road and Station Road, South Norwood.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place:
 - (a) no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the following lengths of streets:
 - (i) Cargreen Road, at its junction with Station Road, South Norwood;
 - (ii) Clifford Road, from the party wall of Nos. 2 and 4 Clifford Road to the party wall of Nos. 19 and 21/23 Clifford Road;
 - (iii) Station Road, South Norwood,
 - (1) the south-eastbound and north-westbound carriageway, from the party wall of Nos. 19 and 21 Station Road, South Norwood and a point 5 metres south-east of the south-eastern flank wall of No. 33 Station Road, South Norwood;
 - (2) the existing one-way workings will be suspended in Station Road referred to in (1) above and in Clifford Road, between its junctions with Carmichael Road and Portland Road;
 - (b) At any time' waiting restrictions will be introduced in the following lengths of streets:
 - (i) Cargreen Road, between its junctions with Station Road, South Norwood and Lawrence Road;
 - (ii) Lawrence Road, from its junction with Cargreen Road to the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 15/17 Lawrence Road
 - (c) temporarily close any road, introduce banned turns, footway closures or waiting and loading restrictions at any time in any street referred to above or any adjoining streets to those mentioned to vehicular traffic where this is considered necessary to facilitate the work in progress;
 - (d) suspend parking bays where this is considered necessary to facilitate the work in progress should this be required;
 - (e) temporarily suspend any other traffic restriction as required;
 - (f) vehicular access will be maintained during the works.
3. Whilst the road closures remain in force the

alternative route for vehicles will be:

- (a) in Cargreen Road via Selhurst Road and Lawrence Road;
 - (b) in Clifford Road for traffic approaching from a south-easterly direction via Carmichael Road, Birchanger Road, Elborough Road, Crowther Road and Portland Road;
 - (c) in Station Road, via the opposite carriageway between Cargreen Road and the south-eastern extremity of Station Road, South Norwood (the carriageways will be closed alternately).
4. The Order will come into operation on 16 August, 2010 and it is anticipated that any work once commenced will be carried out in 4 weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984, SECTION 14 AS AMENDED THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 AND ALL OTHER ENABLING POWERS SANDERSTEAD ROAD, SOUTH CROYDON TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate engineering works associated with the Southern Gas Network mains replacement scheme they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic movements in Sanderstead Road and in side roads where necessary. The works will be carried out in 4 stages and the closure will be implemented to suit the stages as works progress.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Sanderstead Road:
 - (a) Stage 1 – between its junctions with Purley Road and Broomhall Road and with an anticipated duration of 6 weeks;
 - (b) Stage 2 – between its junctions with Broomhall Road and Kendall Avenue and with an anticipated duration of 6 weeks, during this stage access to Broomhall Road and Glossop Road will be maintained from both sides of the Sanderstead Road closure;
 - (c) Stage 3 – between its junctions with Kendall Avenue and Station Approach and with an anticipated duration of 4 weeks;
 - (d) Stage 4 – between its junctions with Station Approach and St Mary's Road and with an anticipated duration of 2 weeks;
 - (e) temporarily introduce any other temporary traffic management measures into any adjoining streets to Sanderstead Road or upon the diversion route outlined below; and
 - (f) temporarily introduce banned turns or waiting restrictions at any time throughout the week should this be required.
3. Whilst the Order remains in force the alternative route:
 - (a) During all stages Sanderstead Road will be open for 'local access' only for southbound traffic between Brighton Road and Purley Road;
 - (b) Southbound traffic will be diverted via Brighton Road, Purley Downs Road, Downsway and Purley Oaks Road;
 - (c) During all stages Sanderstead Road will be open for 'local access' only for northbound traffic as far as St Mary's Road;
 - (d) Northbound traffic will be diverted via Beech Avenue, Brighton Road, Purley Oaks Road and St Mary's Road.
